- 1) School Schedule
 - a. School reopened on April 3rd after spring break.
 - b. School was closed on April 10th for Eid.

2) Student Activities

- a. Mock elections were held on April 4th as a culminating civics activity. This project was conducted in partnership with the Rendell Center. Students in grades K-8 participated in each phase of the project from read-a-louds, registration and voting for one of the four Philly team mascots. SWOOP was the winner.
- b. Field trips are scheduled to the Zoo, National Constitution Center and Legoland this month. Each class was provided with two trips at no cost to parents using ESSER funds.
- c. School was dismissed early on April 8th in advance of the eclipse. KACS dismissal time would have occurred at the height of the eclipse.
- d. The Algebra I bridge program (Saturday class for seventh graders) ended on April 13. Twenty -five to thirty (25-30) rising eight graders will be recommended to study Algebra I in eighth grade.
- e. PSSA tests are scheduled for April 22 through April 30. Two adults will be assigned to monitor each classroom.
- f. Second trimester progress reports will be sent to parents on April 19th.

3) Facility

- a. BSI is working on the punch list. Lockers have been installed; art room windows will be cut and installed during the summer. Touch up work is in progress e.g., power washing portion of exterior, replacement of damaged floor tiles, etc. The contract with AR Spruce will end this week.
- b. Bollards have been installed on three sides of school. A proposal for painting these appears on the agenda.
